

OSUEA Policy on Cooperator Awards

Each year, Oregon State University Extension Association (OSUEA) honors individuals and businesses who have made significant contributions to Extension programs. The OSUEA membership encourages Extension staff and faculty to nominate worthy cooperators from across the state. OSUEA feels that cooperators selected for an award will be honored at the annual cooperator banquet during the Extension Annual Conference on the Oregon State University campus, in Corvallis. OSUEA members and OSU Extension Administrative partners are committed to providing recognition to these outstanding individuals and/or businesses.

OSUEA Honors Cooperator Award Recipients with the following “award package”

- One motel room per award (if needed). Additional rooms can be reserved, however they will need to be covered (paid) by someone else.
- Two banquet tickets per award (These tickets are not to be used by OSU faculty or staff) Additional tickets can be purchased.
- A framed certificate of recognition
- A gift

How the “award package” is being covered financially

OSUEA will pay for:

- Half the cost of one (1) hotel room, if room is needed
- Half the cost of up to two (2) banquet tickets (awardee and a guest)
- A framed certificate of recognition
- A gift

Additional Support from Nominators Required

OSUEA requests financial assistance from the nominating county/program area/department, by providing:

- \$60 per award to aid in the expenses incurred supporting the awardees
- Half the cost of up to two (2) banquet tickets (awardee and a guest)
- Half the cost of one (1) hotel room, if room is needed

Participation in the Cooperator Awards program has expanded, through greater number of nominations. Collaborative financial support allows us to continue to honor these exceptional partners that work with the OSU Extension Service.
