Following graduation from NCSU, Brian Himelbloom completed a postdoctorate in the microbiology department at the University of Massachusetts in Amherst in 1987. Next, he joined the University of Alaska Fairbanks (UAF) as an Assistant Professor of Seafood Microbiology, under the tutelage of the late Dr. Jong Lee, and Brian's initial research projects involved characterizing the microflora of surimi operations at a shore-based surimi plant in Alaska. Brian was tenured and promoted to Associate Professor of Seafood Microbiology in 1994. His career spanned thirty years in residence at the UAF Fishery Industrial Technology Center, later renamed as the Kodiak Seafood and Marine Science Center.
