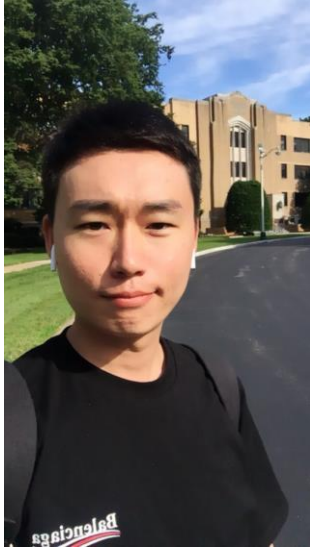

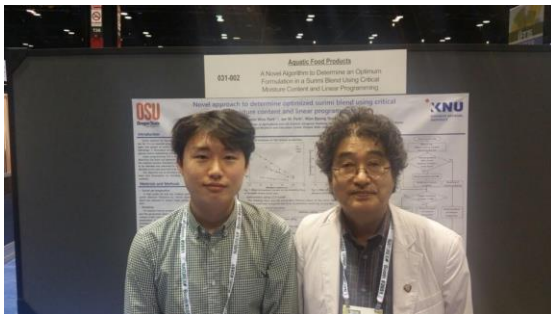


Howard has been working with Dr. Huang as a visiting researcher in USDA ARS. He is working on disinfection of low moisture food using chlorine dioxide gas.
