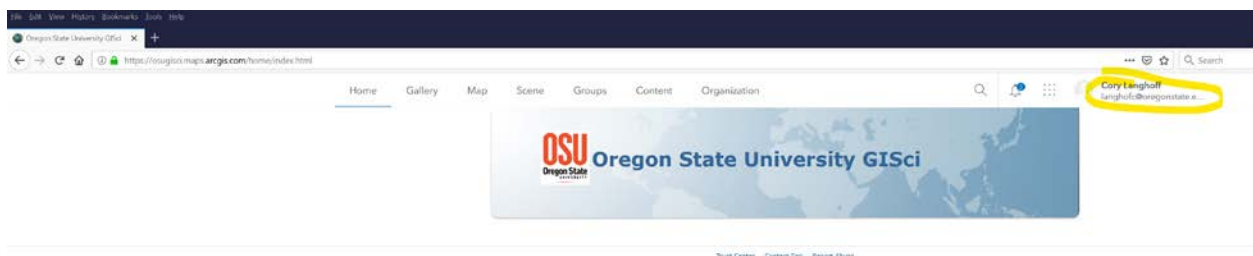
Click on the Oregon State University button to be redirected to an ONID login page.



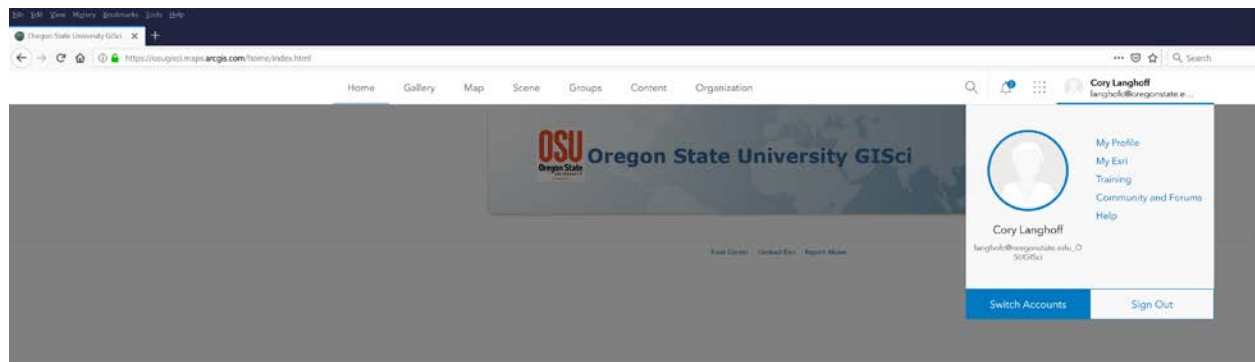
Enter your OSU ONID credentials here.
