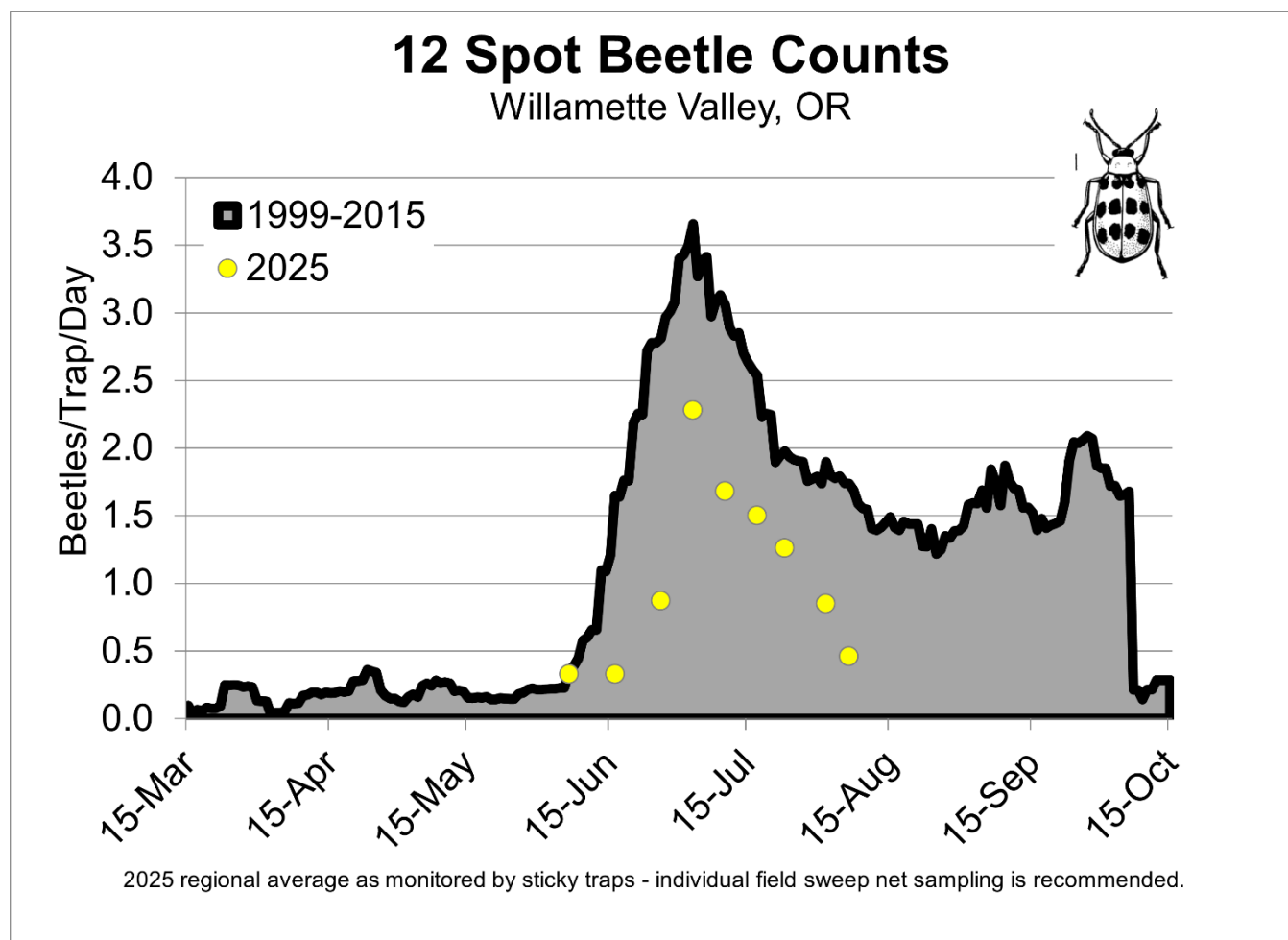

SUMMARY:

- Cutworm and looper counts remain very low.
- The regional average for corn earworm is also lower than normal so far, but activity of this pest usually increases between now and the end of September.
- 12-spot beetle (also known as southern corn rootworm) is monitored via yellow sticky traps placed at the edge of sweet corn and snap bean fields. Counts have been within normal limits, but sweep net sampling is always recommended, particularly throughout snap bean pod development.
