Eligibility & Benefits

Association Membership

Faculty and support staff who have Extension responsibilities are eligible for membership in OSUEA. Payment of annual dues ensures membership benefits. Life memberships are offered to retiring OSUEA members. The annual meeting of members is held during the OSU Extension Annual Conference. The purpose of the meeting is to elect officers and conduct business of the association.

Cooperator Awards

Each year, OSU Extension Service Cooperator Awards (sponsored by OSUEA) honor individuals and businesses who have made significant contributions to Extension programming in Oregon. Extension cooperators include 4-H Leaders, Master Gardeners, Master Food Preservers, farmers and ranchers engaged in agricultural research, Master Woodland Managers and many other individuals, organizations and businesses who work in collaboration with Extension professionals to benefit all Oregonians.

Member Recognition

OSUEA and each affiliate have recognition as an important part of membership. Service to the organization, leadership, curriculum design, teaching, research, communication tools, innovative programming, and audience impact is recognized by professionals in each affiliate, by OSUEA, and at the national level for each affiliate. Applications are required and available each year from OSUEA and affiliate recognition committees.
