Endowment Details

- The principle of the OSU Extension Professional Development Fund is an endowment.
- Earnings from the Endowment feed into the *current-use-funds*.
- Each quarter, the distribution to the *current-use-fund* supports professional development awards to current employees.





Current Endowment

The fund principal is held as an endowment. Earnings feed into a current-use fund, sustaining 100–160 professional development opportunities each year.

*The fund is solely dedicated to **current employee professional development**.*
